TRIUMPH-6 is a clinical research study from Eli Lilly and Company. The **TRIUMPH-6** study will test if an investigational medicine (medicine being studied) can help people with obesity maintain a lower body weight safely over time.

Can I join this study?

Yes, you may be able to join the research study if you:

- are aged 18 years or older
- have a BMI of 35 or more
- have tried to lose weight by changing what you eat but it did not work
- have not taken weight loss medication(s) for at least 3 months before the start of the study
- do not have diabetes
- are not pregnant

BMI stands for body mass index. It compares a person’s weight to their height. It can be used to check if someone is at risk for certain health conditions. If you do not know what your BMI is, you can ask your doctor.
