The services provided by the Adam Practice are;

- **Routine medical checks and general medical services**
NHS relevant prescriptions and medications or a private prescription can be issued.
- **Counselling;**
A Counsellor is available for short-term counselling, for a variety of personal and emotional problems at each of our four sites.
- **Immunisations;**
Including childhood immunisations
- **Foreign travel and immunisations**
- **Weight loss and Dietician clinic lifestyle management;**
At the Adam Practice, we strive to offer help, support and advice to patients who want to lose weight and maintain a healthier lifestyle.
- **Executive & employee medicals;**
Our GP's are able to carry out medical reports and reviews outside of NHS services.
- **Assessment of employees returning to work after illness**
- **Smoking Cessation;**
Any patient who is a smoker and ready to stop smoking will be seen by one of our GP's\Nurse Practitioners or Long Term Conditions Nurse and referred to an appropriate service
- **Respiratory clinic;**
The Adam Practice has facilities for and spirometry / lung function testing at each of its four surgeries.
- **Diabetic clinic;**
The Adam Practice operates diabetes clinics at each of its sites each week to provide ongoing care for our diabetic patients run by trained nurses.
- **Phlebotomy;**
The Adam Practice offers clinics for blood tests at all four sites.



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- **Family planning/Well Woman;**
Contraception and HRT advice are supplied as part of this service. Any patient who requires Family Planning services (e.g. IUD\coil insertion) will be seen by one of our GP's\Nurse Practitioners and referred to the appropriate service.
- **Flu vaccination;**
At the Adam Practice we offer 'at risk' groups the flu vaccine at a certain time each year to protect you against the flu virus.
- **Midwifery;**
The community midwives hold their own clinics at each of our sites for our patients. They supervise antenatal care, undertake deliveries in hospital and at home where appropriate.
- **Minor surgery;**
We offer a number of minor operations/surgeries for dermatology related concerns. The minor operations are held at each of our sites by arrangement following consultations with a GP.
- **Physiotherapy;**
NHS Physiotherapy is available at the Adam Practice.
- **Ear syringing;**
The Adam Practice has facilities for ear syringing at each of our four sites.
- **Specialist dermatology clinic;**
We have a Partner, Dr Seal, with special expertise in dermatology working within our Poole Surgery.
- **Well person checks;**
These can be carried out with any practice nurse.
- **ECG monitoring;**
At the Adam Practice we have ECG machines at each site.
- **Cervical screening;**
At the Adam Practice our nurses are qualified to carry out cervical screening and tests in the form of cervical smears.
